ANNUAL GOLF TOURNAMENT TO BENEFIT CANCER CHARITIES, WICHITA FESTIVALS

WICHITA, Kan. – Organizers announced today that the 2017 Bob Struble Memorial Golf Tournament, presented by Security 1st Title, will benefit Wichita Festivals, Inc., The Hope Funds for Cancer Research and the Wichita Cancer Foundation.

The 12th-annual charity benefit event, held in memory of a longtime Wichita Festivals volunteer who passed away from cancer in 2005, is set for Friday, Sept. 8 on Crestview Country Club's North Course.

“This is a beautiful afternoon of golf, Festivals’ style,” said Mary Beth Jarvis, president and CEO of WFI. “The tournament includes great gifts and prizes and a lot of fun, all while honoring the memory of a wonderful volunteer and benefiting cancer research and treatment.”

Bob Struble served for many years as a Wagonmaster and Riverfest volunteer. He was on the Wichita Festivals Board of Directors and chaired the board in 1995-1996.

The tournament, established in 2006 by Struble’s friends, is flighted, and players compete for lavish prizes, including golf packages to Flint Hills National, Crestview Country Club, Wichita Country Club and more. Lunch, beverages on the course, a lidded/insulated copper tumbler, and pizza following the tournament are included.

Tournament check-in and lunch begin at 11:30 a.m., followed by a 12:30 p.m. shotgun start. Online registration is available now at \$175 per player or \$700 for a 4-person team.
